This qualification reflects the role of support workers who complete specialised tasks and functions in aged services; either in residential, home or community based environments. Workers will take responsibility for their own outputs within defined organisation guidelines and maintain quality service delivery through the development, facilitation and review of individualised service planning and delivery.

Workers may be required to demonstrate leadership and have limited responsibility for the organisation and the quantity and quality of outputs of others within limited parameters.

This qualification gives you career options as a care supervisor, disability officer, team leader and more.

NOTE: Students studying this course are required by law to obtain an Australian Police check.

## \*ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

To be eligible to enroll in the Higher Level Skills program, you must:

- Be a Queensland resident (an Australian citizen/ permanent resident or a New Zealand citizen)
- Be aged 15 years or over
- Be no longer at school (with exception of VET in Schools students)
- Not have completed or be enrolled in a certificate IV level or higher qualification (excluding qualifications completed at school and foundations skills training)

### **COURSE DELIVERY**

The course duration is 39 weeks inclusive of 120 hours practicum as part of compulsory vocational placement where you can start practicing your new skills in a real-world environment.
